#### **Mobilities**

Mobilities of students, teachers and managers are in process: So far, students, teachers and managers from the Bosnia-Herzegovina partner school have spent respectively one months, two weeks and one week in Slovenia at the Slovenian partner school.

Students and teachers from Albania, Kosovo and Montenegro have been on mobility in Denmark and during the coming months, other students, teachers and managers from Montenegro, Kosovo and Bosnia-Herzegovina will go to Spain, The Netherlands, Slovenia or Denmark.

The mobility periods of the students are divided in two parts: one part in classes at the EU partner VET school and another part at work in a private company. Teachers and managers are having training and participate in excursions and meetings with relevant local stakeholders.
